



The Priory, Burwood Road

This was one of the first mansions built on Burwood Road in 1877 by Mowbray Forrest, previously of Yarras Station near Kelso. The land was purchased by Forrest from C. Humphrey. His wife, Elizabeth was a member of the pioneering Kite family of Bathurst. Mowbray Forrest became an alderman and was a founding trustee of the Burwood School of Arts.



The Priory is a two storey Victorian mansion. This house features a three storey elaborately decorated tower, a two storey verandah with cast iron balustrades and an attractive bay window. It has an expansive garden.
